A bill passed in the previous legislature session requiring the purchase of new voting machines every election cycle or if not purchased, necessitating hand counting. The bill is called WORM (Write Once Read Many) which is an "optical disk technology that allows you to write data onto a disk just once" and will become effective in 2026. County Clerk Clark will email information to the Commissioners.
