AGENDA ITEM #1-Workshop regarding funds from opioid settlements







AGENDA ITEM #2-Discuss with possible action on opioid settlement funds


Judge Melton stated that the opioid settlement funds are \$14,000. Commissioner Nabours moved to use the funds to begin the Sabine County Drug Program with the Hughes Center for a 7-month pilot program. Commissioner Jacks seconded. All in favor. Motion carried. See attached.
