Approved. A motion was made and seconded to add one single bunk to cells E and F, making the total capacity for each cell, two. One double bunk added to cell B to be utilized for no more than 48 hours at a time, making the total capacity for cell B, six. The total number of variance beds is four. Adding the additional beds would exceed the jail requirement of clear square footage required in cell B by 13.70 square foot short per inmate. Approved variance for a six-month period, until the November 2023 Commission Meeting.
