Emergency Management Coordinator David Roach asked the public to be aware of hurricane season and consider local news vs. national networks in receiving weather updates.

Mike Mills with the Texas Department of Emergency Management gave an update on recent storms.

Judge Melton thanked the commissioners, emergency personnel and fire fights for their services involving the recent damages caused by severe thunderstorms. They worked over and beyond the call of duty.
