WHEREAS, Sabine County finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Sabine County, that the Law Enforcement Program be operated for the year 2024; and


WHEREAS, Sabine County agrees to provide zero matching funds or the said project as required by the Justice Assistance Grant Program grant application; and



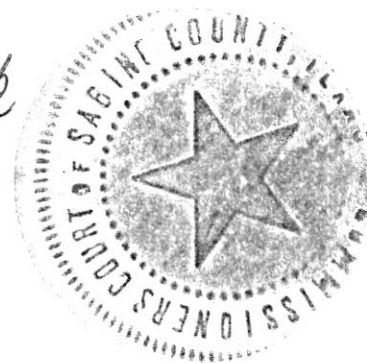
