WHEREAS, Sabine County Sheriff's Department will follow all requirements set forth by SB 22 expenditures for grant program; and





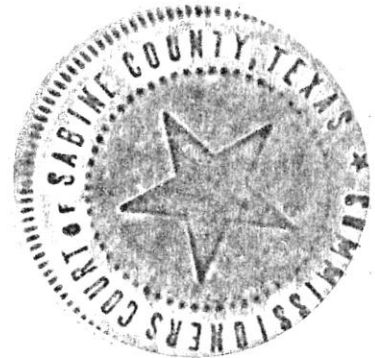
