

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF THE COUNTY OF SABINE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR THE RURAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUND PHASE II; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE RURAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PILOT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Commissioner's Court of Sabine County desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of Sabine County to apply for Phase II funding under the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program Rural Economic Development Fund Pilot Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program application for the Rural Economic Development Fund Phase II is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the County with the Texas Department of Agriculture.
2. That the County's application is part of a Pilot program for funding under the Community Development Fund.
3. That the application be for \$1,000,000.00 of grant funds to construct an outdoor amphitheater.
4. That the Commissioner's Court directs and designates the County Judge as the County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the County's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program Rural Economic Development Phase II pilot program.
5. That all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local and programmatic requirements including but not limited to procurement, environmental review, labor standards, real property acquisition and civil rights requirements.
6. That it further is stated that the County of Sabine is committing a required 10% match not to exceed \$100,000.00 from its General Fund toward the construction, administration and/or engineering activities of this Rural Economic Development Project.
