Commissioner Lowe moved to pay Accounts and Salaries. Commissioner Nabours seconded. All in favor. Motion carried. See attached.






AGENDA ITEM #11-Public Comments

Phil Yocom stated that a \$50,000 grant was received to purchase equipment and dining room items for Pineland Senior Nutrition center.


Sheriff Tom Maddox and Chief Deputy George Griffith reported on Alert Training conducted last week for personnel-.
