# **Engineering Study for Speed Limit Reduction**

Mr. Allison, on your 9/10 response to Commissioner Anderson, you stated that Commissioners Court can set speed limits lower than 30mph when "the road is located 1) in a "residence district" with at least 300 feet of frontage with residences or businesses or 2) within 500 feet of a school with an engineering study."

My question is this: does the engineering study requirement apply to both #1 (300' of residence frontage) and #2 (within 500' of a school district) or just #2?

For example, if I have a dead-end road that has more than 300' of residence frontage, can we set the speed limit to 20mph without an engineering study?

# A PETITION BY PROPERTY OWNERS OF SABINE COUNTY, REQUESTING THE COMMISSIONERS COURT TO LOWER THE SPEED LIMIT TO 20 MPH ON Laguna Bend Road, Pct 2

Sec. 545.355. AUTHORITY OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT TO ALTER SPEED LIMITS. (a) The commissioners court of a county, for a county road or highway outside the limits of the right-of-way of an officially designated or marked highway or road of the state highway system and outside a municipality, has the same authority to increase prima facie speed limits from the results of an engineering and traffic investigation as the Texas Transportation Commission on an officially designated or marked highway of the state highway system.

(b) The commissioners court of a county may declare a lower speed limit of not less than:

(1) 30 miles per hour on a county road or highway to which this section applies, if the commissioners court determines that the prima facie speed limit on the road or highway is unreasonable or unsafe; or

(2) 20 miles per hour:

(A) in a residence district, unless the roadway has been designated as a major thoroughfare by a city planning commission;

The road is described as follows:

The road in consideration for 20 MPH Speed Limit Signs is known as Sabine County Road <u>LAGUNA BEND (3<sup>rd</sup> class, county maintained</u>), located west of Pleasurer Bend Road extending a distance of approximately 1108 feet or .210 mile and dead ends.

The parties signed below make application for SPEED LIMIT SIGNAGE of 20 MPH of said road by filing a petition with the Sabine County Commissioners Court on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2024, at a regular meeting of said Court scheduled for that date. Interested parties should also plan to attend the Commissioners Court meeting on the date above.
