WHEREAS, Sabine County agrees to **provide 25% applicable matching funds** for the said project as required by the OOG grant application; and



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Sabine County approves submission of the grant application for the body-worn cameras to the Office of the Governor.





WHEREAS, Sabine County finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Sabine County, that the Law Enforcement Program be operated for the year 2025; and


WHEREAS, Sabine County agrees to provide 25 matching funds or the said project as required by the ~~Justice Assistance Grant Program~~ grant application; and


