Ensure your community's needs are known by using the QR Code to access the Sabine Regional Flood Planning Group's interactive mapping tool (see screenshot below). Simply drop a pin on the map, tell us a little about flooding in the area, and let us know any solutions you might have in mind.

Need culverts replaced? Drop a pin and tell us where.

Need warning sirens and/or gauges? Show us the locations.

Does the roadway leading to the highway in your neighborhood drain slowly and become impassable during heavy rain? Mark it on the map and describe what happens.

It's really that easy. No technical information needed. No engineering degree required. But, a few minutes of your time could bring valuable resources to your community, increase funding opportunities, and is vital to the Flood Planning Group's ability to identify projects and priorities for inclusion in the next regional and statewide flood plan.
