

Monday, January 22, 1990, the Honorable Commissioners' court met in a regular session at 8:30 A. M. with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order by Judge Royce Smith, with Brother Clarence Howell leading the opening prayer.

John Toner, County Extension Agent, presented certificates for Tax Assessor/Collector, Diane Husband, and her deputies, Rhonda Williams and Tammy Sepulvado. These certificates were for attending school at A&M November 12-14, 1989, and in Lufkin October 30 - November 1, 1989. Commissioner Chester Cox made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Conn, to approve these certificates as a matter of record. Motion carried.

After the reading of the minutes of the last meeting, Commissioner McGee said the Satilite could be installed on the water tower at Fox Hunters' Hill, and not the Fire Tower as stated. Commissioner Jimmy Conn made the motion, which was seconded by Commissioner Billy McGee, to approve minutes after this change is made. Motion carried.

Monthly bills were inspected for payment. Commissioner McGee made the motion, seconded by Commissioner Cox, to approve payment of accounts and salaries. Motion carried.

According to Art. 3912k, the Salary Grievance Committee is chosen each January. Besides the County Judge, Sheriff, County Clerk, District Clerk, Tax Assessor/Collector, County Treasurer and County or District Attorney, three citizens in the County who served on the Grand Jury the previous year are also chosen. These names are pulled at randum. Those names pulled were Willie Williams, Kathy McBride, and J. C. Click. These people will be notified by mail. Commissioner McGee made the motion, which was seconded by Commissioner McDaniel, to approve these names. Motion carried.

With Commissioner McGee making the motion, and Commissioner McDaniel seconding, the Court approved the purchase of a new speed radar unit for Patrolman Bradberry's patrol car. This will cost approximately \$2,000.00. All voted for.

Constable Jerry Dan Webb presented a bill for attending school in Jasper. This was \$250.00, which he has paid. Commissioner Jimmy Conn made the motion to reimburse him for this amount. Commissioner Billy McGee seconded, and motion carried.

Commissioner Carlin McDaniel made the motion to adopt the Sanitary Land Fill resolution presented. Commissioner Billy McGee seconded this motion, and motion carried. "See attached exhibit" This resolution is similar to one passed by West Texas officials asking the E.P.A. to allow variances in some instances. Mentioned in the resolution were rural areas seeking an extension of the time allowed to comply with new regulations for closing or maintaining land fills.

A discussion followed concerning applying for permits for closing land fills by April. No action was taken.

Mr. Madison Moore, from Shady Acres Subdivision in Prct. 2 was present requesting the County to take over roads in that subdivision as County maintained roads. Commissioner McGee stated that requests have been received from other residents in the County, and suggested that the Court put all these requests in one package,

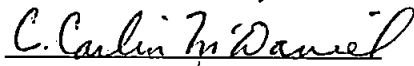
and approve them at one time at a later date. Commissioner McGee then made a motion, which was seconded by Commissioner Cox, to submit Shady Acres Subdivision as one of the future roads to be considered as County roads. Motion carried.

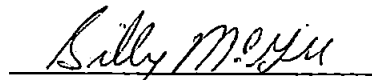
Motion was made by Commissioner Carlin McDaniel and seconded by Commissioner Billy McGee, to renew two time warrants for Prct. 2 by paying interest on each, and renewing for one year. All voted for. \$10,581.26 is due on a 1985 Mack Dump truck; interest on this is \$634.87. \$5,000.00 is due on purchase of five acres of land located south of Pineland. Interest on this is \$299.99. The interest on both warrants was from January 17, 1989 to January 17, 1990, and figured at the rate of 6%. The beginning rate of the renewal is National Prime plus 2, floating, which is 12%, beginning Jan. 17, 1990.

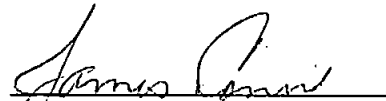

Motion was then made by Commissioner McGee, and seconded by Commissioner Conn, that meeting adjourn. Motion carried.

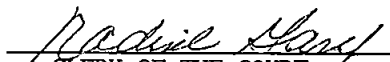

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency has proposed new regulations pursuant to Subtitle D of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (53 Fed. Reg. 33314, 8/30/88) which would establish nationwide minimum standards for municipal solid waste landfills; and

WHEREAS, those regulations are designed to eliminate small existing municipal landfills and encourage large regional state-of-the-art- landfills; and,

WHEREAS, extremely low population densities in Sabine County making compliance with the proposed Subtitle D regulations a financial impossibility; and,

WHEREAS, in Sabine County with existing soil conditions make the possibility of groundwater contamination from a landfill remote;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioner's Court of Sabine County that:

- (1) Sabine County is committed to environmentally safe and prudent disposal of municipal wastes, but believes that waste disposal requirements must be within the realm of economic possibility.
- (2) Sabine County requests the Environmental Protection Agency to consider revisions to proposed Subtitle D regulations which would authorize State regulatory agencies sufficient flexibility to grant variances in national standards in areas of extremely low population density, upon a showing that the County landfill facility does not pose a significant threat to the environment or groundwater quality.
- (3) the Texas Department of Health, United States Senators Bentsen and Gramm, and United States Congressman Charles Wilson are hereby requested to assist the County in obtaining modifications of the proposed EPA Subtitle D regulations which would allow for an economical and environmentally prudent waste disposal alternative in low population density areas.
