**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS and CITY OF HEMPHILL, TEXAS**

This agreement is entered into by the County of Sabine, Texas acting through its Commissioners' Court, and the City of Hemphill, Texas, acting through its City Counsel.

WHEREAS, the County has acquired property from Hemphill ISD, and the property has fencing, bleachers, and lighting.


WHEREAS, the County does not have a need for the fencing, bleachers, and lighting and wants them removed.

WHEREAS, the cost of removal of the fencing, bleachers, and lighting equal or exceeds the value of the fencing, bleachers, and lighting.


WHEREAS, the City of Hemphill desires to acquire the fencing, bleachers, and lighting for purpose of a new baseball field for the City of Hemphill.

NOW THEREFORE, the County agrees to convey all right and title to the fencing, bleachers, and lighting to the City in exchange for the removal of the fencing, bleachers, and lighting at the City's expense.



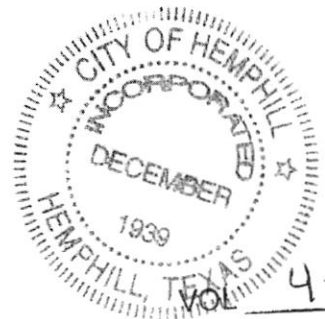
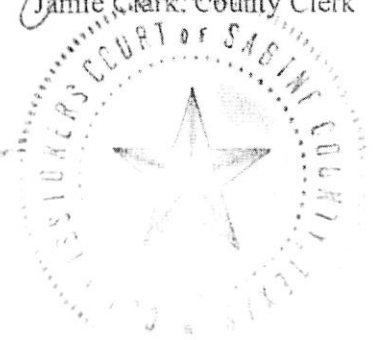

Dear County Judge and Honorable Commissioners,

On behalf of the Hemphill Diamond League, we respectfully submit this request for the consideration of the Sabine County Commissioners Court.

Hemphill Diamond League is a nonprofit youth baseball and softball organization that currently serves approximately 200 youth from Hemphill and the surrounding Sabine County communities. Our league exists to provide safe, structured, and positive athletic opportunities that promote teamwork, discipline, leadership, and community pride for our county's children.

As the county prepares to repurpose the former Hemphill High School baseball field, we respectfully request that Sabine County consider donating the usable field infrastructure and equipment from that location to Hemphill Diamond League. Specifically, we are requesting the donation of the following items, if deemed surplus or no longer needed by the county:

- Perimeter fencing
- Dugout metal and materials
- Helmet storage boxes
- Bat stands
- Bleachers
- Ticket booth structure
- Field lighting, where feasible

For several years, Hemphill Diamond League has been saving funds to purchase land and eventually construct a new baseball and softball complex to serve the youth of Sabine County. The donation of these materials would significantly reduce construction costs and allow us to direct limited resources toward field development, safety improvements, and expanded programming for our players.

This request represents an opportunity to reinvest existing county assets directly back into local youth, ensuring that materials which have served our community once before can continue
