


AGENDA ITEM #2- Workshop, discussion, and presentation with Alan Goss with Heelstone team regarding Cypress Pointe solar project

Alan Goss with Heelstone team gave a presentation and discussed information with the Court, regarding Cypress Pointe solar project.


AGENDA ITEM #3- Adjournment
