Thank you for your response and for the Commissioners' consideration of our request.

At this time, we would like to withdraw the June 13th request, as that date is no longer needed. We are still requesting consideration for July 18, 2026.

To clarify, this request is not tied to, sponsored by, or affiliated with any particular event, nor will it be associated with any specific organized event taking place in the area. Our intention is simply to temporarily set up and operate as an additional food option for the public during normal community activity and visitation within the Square area.

Additionally, should there be activities surrounding the July 4th holiday where an additional food vendor may be beneficial, Coullion's Cajun Food would be interested and available if permitted.

Regarding the question of county property versus city property, our primary goal is simply to secure an appropriate temporary location that is available and approved for operation while providing a convenient food option for the public.

Coullion's Cajun Food already holds the required permit to operate within the area, and we would ensure the location is kept clean and left in good condition following operations.

We appreciate your time and consideration and are happy to provide any additional information needed.
