AGENDA ITEM #15- Public comments

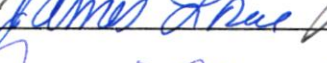
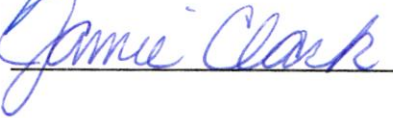
